

Pinwheel Square

1. Cut two $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares from color A fabric and two $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares from color B fabric
2. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of all 3" background squares.
3. Layer a color A $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square and a color B $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square making sure all edges are even. Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the drawn line on each side.



4. Cut on the center line and press towards darker fabric. Each square should be $3\frac{1}{2}$ ".
5. Repeat step four with the other two squares.
6. Open up each triangle to get a half square triangle and iron the seams open from both sides. DO NOT stretch fabric while you are ironing.



7. Sew the Half Square Triangles into pinwheel blocks as shown below. Press each rows seams in opposing directions.
